On 1st to 31st of May 2023 we had an opportunity to visit the home for the disabled, Bansillapet, Secunderabad. This institution has a number of remarkable and unique characteristics of who are differently able, with men, women and children around 350 inmates. Serving others is a hallmark of our Christianity. The Bible teaches us that Jesus Christ dedicated His service to others and encourages His followers to do the same. As we follow the Lord's teaching as He said "Love one another as I have loved you, and love them as your own brothers and sisters." (John 13:34). The Bible also shows that helping other people, serves God and yields blessings. This was a golden opportunity to show our love and care for them.

The day begins at 5 am for the inmates and the home is full of life with different activities. This is a home of a different kind inmates, many are self-reliant do their own work, help each other and play with each other. When we have spent our little time with the inmates we could feel the need which they lack, that is none other than "love." The one more thing that we have observed in them is that, out of their own problems and struggles they are happy and contended with what they have and they are thankful to God. Great acts are made up of small deeds. Through father Xavier S.V.D classes we have gained much knowledge about Bible and the world, it was good to have such a knowledgeable person. We were inspired by the services he is rendering to these abandoned ones.

Service to man is service to God. The greatest achievement of the home for the disabled is its ability to motive the public and at large to help the less privileged human beings. We were happy to be with them and listened to them and help them. We consider it as our privilege to be with them and learn from them many things such as patience, generosity being more responsibility and accepting the each one person as they are. As our founder says, "Ascending to God and going out to the people those who are in need." We realized that the beauty of our life consist in doing God's will that is to look after this kind of people.

In this home the more able are at the service of the less able the love with which they tend to those under their care shows the responsibility they feel and the keenness to work to the best of their ability. As we see ourselves though having everything sometimes we become disabled without showing our concern towards our fellow human beings. The atmosphere in the home is a joyous one. There are no irritable faces there. We have experienced that this is a community of positive people who have no great expectations, no complaints they are grateful and at peace with themselves are inspiration for us and for the world outside ridden with conflict, stress and sickness.

We also realized how privilege we are to be blessed by God with every good thing in the life. It helped us to be grateful to God. With our own eyes we see the generosity of people.

And also we have seen that they sensitize each and every one who enters their gates and we believe that this is not a home for the disabled but a home for the differently able, because the disabled come into the home and become differently able. Our visit to this home reminds us what Jesus Christ our Lord has said "I came to serve not to be served" we can say that our saying of our Lord is true in the case of these children who work among the helpless.

Once again e thank Sr Mukta Xess the provincial superior and council and Sr. Bridgit Govindu our TPS Directress for giving us this opportunity to be with these people to work on this institution. Thank you sisters for enriching our lives with this experience.




