1. AMR (Awareness, meditation, Relaxation)
2. CAP (Child, Adult and parent)
3. Go away Mt 4:4-11 – 3 temptation
4. No self conclusion or self judgment (John8:10-11)
5. CAB (Cognitive, Effectiveness and Behaviour)
6. Mt 26:36- Self exploration, self acceptance and self giving
7. W5H1 (What, who, when, which, why, How)

Psycho spiritual integration also helps us to discover our own self to live in peace and harmony within and around us to realize our strengths / inner resources which are within us and help to expand ourselves. The moment we change our thinking pattern positively, the feelings within us also change positively, which has an impact on our body.

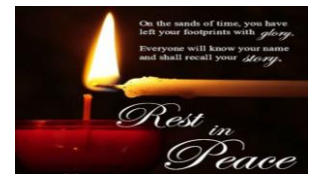
